## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

**OF** 

## BROCKMAN POINTE ASSOCIATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 317A, Minnesota Statutes, known as the Minnesota Non-Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

## **ARTICLE I**

## BROCKMAN POINTE ASSOCIATION /

The name of this corporation shall be Brockman Pointe Association.

## ARTICLE II

## **PURPOSES**

The purpose of this corporation shall be to promote the health, safety, and welfare of residents of a condominium development called Brockman Pointe Condominium located on real property situated in the City of Northfield, County of Rice, and State of Minnesota, legally described as set forth on attached Exhibit A, together with any additions thereto of property which is subjected to the condominium pursuant to the Declaration of Brockman Pointe Condominium and the provisions of M.S. 515B, commonly known as the Minnesota Common Interest Ownership Act, and in accordance with recorded declarations, covenants, easements and restrictions applicable to said property.

For the purposes aforesaid, the corporation shall have the following powers:

- a. To operate and function exclusively a non-profit corporation, with the rights, powers and privileges granted by Chapter 317A of the Minnesota Statutes;
- b. To act as the Association which is referred to in the Declaration of Brockman Pointe Condominium, Rice County Common Interest Community ("CIC")

Number 41 filed or to be filed with the office of the Rice County Registrar of Titles, Faribault, Minnesota, which Association is obligated to provide for the operation and management of Brockman Pointe Association empowered as and required by the Declaration, the By-Laws of this corporation, and by law.

c. To perform all actions as set forth in M.S. 515B.3-102, except as limited by the provisions of the Declaration of or the By-Laws of the corporation.

## ARTICLE III

## NO PECUNIARY GAIN

This corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its Members.

## ARTICLE IV

## **DURATION**

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

## ARTICLE V

## REGISTERED OFFICE

The location of the registered office of this corporation shall be 1895 Plaza Drive, Suite 200, Eagan, Minnesota 55122.

## ARTICLE VI

## DIRECTORS

The business of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors initially consisting of three persons and thereafter as provided in the By-Laws. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as members of the first Board of Directors until the first annual meeting of the corporation, or as otherwise provided in the By-Laws, are as follows:

## ARTICLE VII

## LIABILITY

The Members of this corporation shall not be subject to any personal liability for corporation obligations.

## ARTICLE VIII

## CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation shall have no capital stock.

## ARTICLE IX

## **MEMBERSHIP**

The Members of the corporation shall be those persons described in the By-Laws as Members of this corporation.

## ARTICLE X

## **VOTING RIGHTS**

The corporation shall have one class of voting membership. Votes shall be allocated to each unit as provided in the Declaration and the By-Laws. The Declarant will have special Declarant rights within the meaning of M.S. 515B.1-103(31) to control the operation and

administration of this corporation for as long as it owns a unit or for such shorter period as set forth in the Declaration and the By-Laws.

## ARTICLE XI

## DISSOLUTION

The corporation may be dissolved with the assent of not less than three-fourths (3/4) of the votes of the membership, such assent to be in writing and signed by the Members holding such votes. Upon dissolution of the corporation, other than as incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the corporation shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this corporation was created. In the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed and assigned to any non-profit corporation, association, trust or other organization to be devoted to such similar purposes.

## ARTICLE XII

## **AMENDMENTS**

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended, at a meeting called for said purposes, by a vote of members holding not less than three-fourths (3/4) of the votes of the voting membership, present in person or by proxy.

## ADOPTION OF BY-LAWS

The first Board of Directors shall, upon the first meeting thereof, adopt By-Laws for the regulation of the business of the corporation, and such By-Laws shall be of full force and effect unless amended as provided therein.

## ARTICLE XV

## DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS/FEDERAL HOUSING ADMINISTRATION APPROVAL

As long as the period of Declarant control continues (as defined in M.S. 515B.1-103(22), the following actions will require the prior approval of the Department of Veterans Affairs or the Federal Housing Administration: Amendments to the Declaration, mergers and consolidations, dissolution and amendment of these Articles, amendments of the By-Laws, mortgaging of the Common Elements, and dedication of the Common Elements to a party other than the Association.
